General Orders:

6 - To receive, obey and pass on to the sentry who relieves me, all orders from the Commanding Officer, Command Duty Officer, Officer of the Deck, and Officers and Petty Officers of the Watch only.

From now on, any documents that need to be turned into admin will be turned into the quarterdeck. The quarterdeck will be responsible for delivering any coursework, documents, etc. to admin. during their security checks.

PRT makeups will be held on Saturday. Be prepared and ready yourself for them. PT is something you need to prepare and work on. Cadets need to be physically prepared as well as mentally when attending any drills or training evolutions.

Naval History for December

December 7, 1941

Japanese planes attacked the United States Naval Base at Pearl Harbor , Hawaii Territory, killing more than 2,300 Americans. The U.S.S. ... The following day, in an address to a joint session of Congress, President Franklin Roosevelt called December 7, 1941 "a date which will live in infamy."

December 9, 1938

A prototype shipboard radar, XAF, designed and built by the Naval Research Laboratory, is installed on USS New York (BB-34). Installation on U.S. Navy vessels begins in 1940 and proves fruitful in detecting the enemy in World War II.


December 27, 1990

Lt. Cmdr. Darlene Iskra, the first female commanding officer of a U.S. Navy warship, reports for duty on board USS Opportune (ARS 41), then at Naples, Italy, serving until 1993.

December 29, 1798

Secretary of Navy Benjamin Stoddert sends in his first annual report to Congress, requesting naval forces be increased "to make the most powerful nation desire our friendship - the most unprincipled respect our neutrality."
